II Old Business

Minutes from the July 16, 2009 meeting needed the following correction: to change Chuck Tyson to Charles Tyson and the city will pay for 2500 Home Tour brochures, not 500 as listed. Minutes were approved as corrected.

The Treasurer's report: We have a total of \$4,138.74 in both the checking and savings accounts. This includes \$23.00 deposited from Tukwila Days (\$13.00 from the sale of Home brochures and a \$10.00 donation)

III New Business

Pat passed around the revised Tukwila Home & Buildings Tour Guide. It was noted that Home #18 on the Guide has a misspelled name in it. It should be Mrs Huson rather than 'Heusen' Per Pat we sold 4 History books and 2 River Legacy CD's. John suggested that we get the History book out to Borders for more exposure. Pat mentioned that pictures are still being requested as part of the Duwamish Riverbend Hill project.

Jenny said this coming September 14th will be the 1st anniversary of the 'Healing of the Land' and that she is suggesting that Mayor Haggerton give a proclamation recognizing Tukwila's First Nations People and calling for a commemoration of the 'First Nation Day'. She also is trying to get Cecile Hanson on the agenda for the City Council meeting. Jenny did say that Cecile has testified in July for the House committee on Natural Resources but the Duwamish case is still in appeal and they need to raise more funds.

The Time Capsule is to be placed in the ground at Tukwila City Hall at noon, Sept 12th. Items for the capsule need to be submitted by Sept 1st. Pat suggested laminating the River Legacy poster to be placed. And the Tukwila Historical Home Tour brochure will be submitted. Joan suggested that Westfield's at Southcenter be involved and asked that Historical Society members be present along with members from the Duwamish Tribe.

Pat said our book 'Tukwila Community at the Crossroads' be placed in the capsule with a list of Historical Society projects, to include what we've accomplished and events that we've sponsored. Pat suggested the Sept 17th Meeting be at the Nelsen home with appetizers and cookies.
